Section 1: General English (40 Questions)

- **Vocabulary:** Expect questions on Synonyms, Antonyms, and Homonyms.
- **Error Detection:** Sentence correction and editing.
- **Idioms and Phrases:** Popular English expressions and their meanings.
- **Spell Check:** Identifying the correct spelling of complex words.
- **Reading Comprehension:** Passage-based questions to test your speed and understanding.

Section 2: General Knowledge (40 Questions)

This section is broad and requires you to stay updated with both static facts and current events.

- **Indian Geography:** Major rivers, mountains, soils, and national parks. Pay attention to city nicknames (e.g., "Pink City").
- **Indian History:** Focus on the Indian National Movement and key ancient civilizations.
- **Indian Polity:** The Constitution of India, Preamble, Fundamental Rights, and the working of the Parliament.
- **J&K Specific GK:** History, geography, and current administrative updates regarding Jammu & Kashmir.
- **Science & Tech:** Basic concepts of Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, along with recent ISRO/DRDO missions.
- **Current Affairs:** Awards (Bharat Ratna, Padma Awards), Sports (Olympics, IPL), and International Summits.

Section 3: Reasoning (40 Questions)

Reasoning is the scoring section of the JUET syllabus. It tests your logical and analytical thinking.

- **Series Completion:** Numerical series (Fibonacci, squares) and alphabetical patterns.
- **Coding-Decoding:** Solving words based on specific logic or shifts.
- **Blood Relations:** Family tree puzzles.
- **Direction Sense:** North, South, East, West movement problems.
- **Analogies:** Relationship-based logic (e.g., Book : Author :: Film : ?).
- **Odd One Out:** Identifying the element that doesn't fit the logical group.

Section 4: Numerical Ability (30 Questions)

For many, this is the most challenging section. For JUET UG, the level is mostly 10th standard, while for JUET PG, it involves more complex calculations.

- **Arithmetic:** Percentages, Averages, Profit & Loss, and Ratio & Proportion.
- **Interest:** Simple and Compound Interest calculations.
- **Algebra:** Basic linear equations and simplification.
- **Mensuration:** Area and Perimeter of 2D shapes; Volume of 3D shapes like cylinders and spheres.
- **Number System:** Prime numbers, HCF, LCM, and Fractions.
- **Data Interpretation:** Analyzing charts, tables, and graphs.

Pro-Tips for Preparation

- > **Analyze PYQs:** The best way to understand the JUET syllabus is to look at previous year papers. Notice how questions on the Constitution and English Idioms repeat every few years.
- > **Focus on Accuracy:** With a 0.25 negative marking, "guessing" can be dangerous. Only attempt questions where you are at least 70% sure.
- > **J&K Current Affairs:** Since it is a state-level university, expect at least 5–8 questions related specifically to Jammu and Kashmir's culture and current politics.
